ICAN! provides free and confidential services to individuals who have experienced all forms of domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, dating violence, elder abuse and human trafficking.

Services include:

- ◆ 24-hour confidential crisis line;
- ◆ Crisis intervention to assist in getting victim to safety and/or providing information, education, and referrals for additional services;
- ◆ Transportation to a safe place, including various shelters throughout Oklahoma, or assistance to out-of-state locations;
- ◆ Assist in safety planning to assist victims in immediate danger or providing tools to help them as they plan to leave in the future;
- ◆ Advocacy including:
 - ◆ one-on-one support and ongoing assistance,
 - ◆ hospital advocacy, and
 - ◆ court house services;
- ◆ Referrals to our full-time Legal Aid attorney;
- ◆ Assistance with meals and clothing; and
- ◆ Transitional Housing Assistance.

ICAN! provides services to the residents of Canadian and Grady Counties. On average, we provide services to approximately 500 women, children, and men each year.
